International Gare Symbols



The numbers in the wash tub correspond to the **maximum** washing temperatures that must not be exceeded.

The **bar** below the wash tub calls for a mechanically milder treatment (gentle wash cycle). It indicates wash cycles that are suitable for easy-care and mechanically sensitive items, for example.

The **double bar** indicates wash cycles with further minimised mechanics, e.g. for wool.
